Beautiful and practical exterior design

The impressive engineering and design work on the Najad 395 range performed by the world renowned Farr Yacht Design will not pass anyone unnoticed. The all new Najad 395-range has excellent bluewater capabilities. The hull is designed for smooth sailing in heavy seas and dry on deck even in rough weather. **This holds true both under sail and power.**

The deck layout on N395 AC is clean and uncluttered with under deck mounted electric windlass, flush mounted deck hatches and skylights. The large lockers, one drained in bow, one in the cockpit floor and two on aft deck provide generous storage for sails and deck equipment.

The generous wide and lengthy Caribbean style cockpit with twin helm stations provide plenty of space for any manoeuvre. The cockpit is well protected and safe which makes it a very sociable place to entertain family and friends either under way or when mooring in a nice, quiet bay. The broad stern with the large foldable bathing platform, easily operated from the cockpit, is perfect for watersport activities.


The customisation of a Najad is not limited to technical equipment and layout selection. When choosing Najad you can also put a mark on the external character of your yacht.

Arch over cockpit

The arch on the N395 AC increases the safety and protection of the cockpit. The arch constitutes a firm handle when manouevering in the cockpit, enables lighting underneath, conveniently attaches the sprayhood and is a natural stow away place for the sprayhood extension.

Sails

The sails for N395 AC are made of high quality, laminated cloth from UK Sailmakers – one of the world's most established groups of sail makers with over 50 lofts and service centres.

Owners can commission their own sailmakers if that is their preference.

Rigging

N395 AC is equipped with rigging from Seldén – the worlds leading manufacturers of spar and rigging systems. A two spreader aluminium mast and furlex are standard. Electric in-mast and headsail furling is available as an option, as are carbon fibre spars in white or black lacquer.

Saloon and galley

The impressive interior on the N395 AC created by superyacht stylist Ken Freivokh is designed to impress. The material selections and design details with luxurious superyacht influences create a home away from home feeling.


The truly breathtaking saloon and galley offer a spacious living area with the benefit of natural light coming from the many skylights and portlights. The headroom is an impressive 2 meters.

The iconic Najad seagoing galley is retained in the 395 range. The large galley is equipped with an array of equipment such as double sinks, large separated fridge and freezer, microwave, stove and oven. The dining area with its ergonomically designed sofa, and large foldable table, seats at least six comfortably.

Depending on layout selection and demands, the navigation area can include an appropriate forwardfacing table next to the companionway on the starboard side, offering good access to the cockpit and saloon.







Cabins and suites

The total number of layouts and combinations on the Najad 395 series are unprecedented in a 40-foot yacht. N395 AC is available in two or three cabin formats with the option of one or two large heads.

The forward owners' cabin, with its comfortable full queen size double berth, lavish design details, natural light from the large skylight and glass panels creates a bright and roomy atmosphere, with its own walk-in wardrobe. Optional layouts in front of the mast include additional heads or separate shower room with just a shower to port and a seating option to starboard. It's all up to you to decide and customise to suit your needs.

The V berth is standard in the forward cabin however a single berth option is available as pictured opposite.

The standard layout has two aft cabins with long wide beds and large wardrobes for excellent stowage. Those wanting more space instead of berths have two options, to change the starboard aft cabin into an additional stowage area with shelves and compartments or to have a proper forward-facing navigation station with a seat.

The heads and shower rooms on the N395 AC follow the Najad standard with good ventilation, large Corian worktops, roomy showers and ample storage in lockers and cabinets – all made from high-quality materials.



Interior styling and customisation

The interior of the N395 AC is characterised by exquisite craftsmanship, executed with extreme attention to detail. Joinery of the interior and cabinets are crafted for optimal strength and to function perfectly when moored or at sea.

The yacht comes as standard with the hallmark Najad mahogany furnishing with options for both white oak and teak. Throughout the interior you'll find contrasting finish/colour on selected details such as inlays in the companionway, saloon table and skirtings in doors.

When it comes to personalising the interior, the N395 AC is a dream come true for those who value customising. Colours, fabrics, worktops and more can be matched in many different styles to build a unique yacht.
